## Major Developments at ISM

### **Building Expansion :**

The Board is delighted to announce the acquisition of three further floors on top of our current premises at 12 quai Antoine 1<sup>er</sup>.

This will give us one entire floor for Creative Arts (movement, music, drama and art), a new floor reserved for the Middle School (with their own science laboratory) and significantly more space for the Primary School with a second assembly hall.

The space currently used by the Middle School will be used to extend the Early Years Unit, again providing additional classes, as well as more space and some administrative offices.

### **Educational Programmes and the I.G.C.S.E. examinations :**

The Board, in consultation with the teaching staff and the parents of the School Council, has voted unanimously to retain the I.G.C.S.E (University of Cambridge) exams at the end of Year 11. These internationally recognized examinations give the students a clearly defined goal prior to their starting the two year I.B. Diploma programme and are much valued by universities. They are an excellent indication of a student's potential at I.B. Diploma level. Consequently the school will thus officially withdraw from the I.B. Middle Years Programme (MYP) whilst retaining many of its good practices.
